We expect our supply chain, contractors, employees and all other business partners to commit to the same, and therefore, despite not being required to by legislation, we are implementing this policy to monitor and prevent modern slavery within our supply chain.

Our Business

We are a family owned manufacturer and supplier of high quality tea and coffee based in the Royal Arsenal Development in Woolwich, south-east London.

Our Service Partners and Suppliers

We engage with a wide variety of service and goods suppliers, and it is our intention, as part of our Modern Slavery Policy, to audit our supply chain to ensure that all our suppliers are fully compliant. We shall do this through a questionnaire-based system that will roll out during early 2019.

Employees

We check that all employees have the right to live and work in the UK during our pre-employment checks. All employees are paid at least the London Living Wage, as set each year by the Living Wage Foundation. We extend this principle to sub-contractors (e.g. cleaning contractors). We encourage all employees to report any concerns regarding unlawful conduct, malpractice, dangers to the public or the environment, or any other matter of a serious nature.

Policy Supervision

This policy will be reviewed annually by senior management, and its implementation is the responsibility of the Board of Directors.
